20/078 PUBLIC SPEAKING

Members present, and other residents who have spoken to Councillors, expressed concern over the unsocial behaviour on the Recreation Ground. Swearing, drunkenness, taking drugs, urinating, smashing bottles, playing football on the bowling green, congregating in large numbers on Bowls club property, noise and parking in French Lane and continually climbing walls of nearby property to retrieve footballs, were issues raised.

Officers confirmed they were carrying out regular patrols but had seen little unlawful behaviour, but asked residents to keep them informed of issues.

Because many youths from outside of Horsley appear to come because of goal nets, a suggestion was made to remove the goal nets – or even the goal posts for a period.

French Lane residents had met and notices re 'no parking' were being made.

A number of residents had offered to take part in a rota to ensure adults were on the ground in the evenings. The Officers suggested there should be no confrontation if doing so.

THE Project Engineer at AVBC had indicated that ‘no parking’ signs could not be erected in the passing bays and even if put up there was little chance of enforcement.

RESOLVED that the Clerk write to the Manager of the Hermes Depot in Tants Meadow requesting those using the property do not park on the dangerous bends and do no park in passing bays while waiting to load cars.
