Recreation ground

The equipment is in need of a further clean. It was agreed to obtain a quote for a contractor to clean the equipment. There have been a large number of cyclists on the recreation ground despite signage to say this was not allowed. It was agreed to order a no cycling sign.

Footpaths

Councillor Holden gave an update on footpaths and there are generally no concerns. The footpath by The Grange is now easily passable.

Neighbourhood Watch

The NW group had sorted out the ASB on the recreation ground by regular parishioner patrols. The Natter Café is planned to be held every two months.

Fountain

This had been checked over and it was unable to be unblocked. It was agreed to ask for a quote to unblock.

Village Hall

The heating system has been changed to bring heat into the hall at a lower level and a sound limiter has been purchased. Both of these will solve existing problems. Lots of bookings are coming back but most of the fundraisers have been cancelled. It is still hoped to have a bonfire night celebration. The Church and Village Hall are working together to raise funds by having a cake sale with the Natter café. Horsley wall bricks are available again to raise funds.

- AVA/2019/0143 Land Adj Sandy Lane Sandy Lane Coxbench I went to this site in July, the piles of material don't look discernible different from that day. The land owner has said that he is clearing out a section of land that was tipped on by the previous owner. The removal of stone walls would not need the Council's permission, but he has said that he will be using the stone on site to repair and build new stone walls around the site. The owner had also been laying some water pipes that were evident during my site visit, that would also not require any planning permission. Apart from the compound area near the entrance gate I didn't see any other works that would be considered a breach of planning control during my visit.

A trial was scheduled for tomorrow (30th July 2020), but due to lockdown and the increasing court backlog the trial has been put back to later in the year with no actual confirmed date.
