20/035 REPORTS FROM REPRESENTATIVES

Flooding at Lower Kilburn.

In the early hours on 16.2.20 a number of residents at Lower Kilburn had their homes flooded once again. The water came from the 'bottle neck' on Bottle Brook just north of Millbridge kennels, as the volume of water was too great for the small bridge to cope with. Consequently some of the cottages on the west side of Derby road were affected as the water flowed down the B6179 in the direction of Little Eaton. Work observed still being done to dry out the cottages on the 19.2.20. Properties on the east side, numbers 39 & 41, were also affected by rain water coming off the saturated fields to the rear of their homes. The Environmental Agency were in attendance; Sand bags were distributed to the residents.
